As always I would say use your vote wisely and vote for the person you feel best able to represent our community in the corridors of power.


Whoever is the victor we will do our best to work with them in a positive way addressing the issues we face in our local communities.

Green belt house plan turned down

PLANS for a part two-storey dwelling at Cherry Lane Barn, Cherry Lane, Lymm, have been turned down by borough council planners.

Lymm, have been turned down by borough council planners. Lymm Parish Council did not oppose the scheme but the borough council said the proposal would be an inappropriate development harmful to the Green Belt. They also said the scheme would have a significant impact on the openness of the Green Belt. The proposed detached garage would, because of its size and prominent location represent an intrusive element on the street scene to the detriment of the visual amonity of the area.

Currently vacant, the site lies between the existing Cherry Lane barn

conversions and modern housing off Lady Acre Close and Hunts Field Close.

Local borough councillors raised no objections but there was one objection from a neighbour, who believed the scheme represented overdevelopment. Another supported the scheme on the grounds it would improve an overgrown piece of wasteland.

Christmas comes early for family who return to home devastated by fire

CHRISTMAS has come early for a Lymm family who saw their home almost destroyed in a devastating fire two years ago.

On the morning of Saturday 25th November 2017 the Taylor family experienced a devastating house fire which destroyed the roof and first floor of the property leaving the house inhabitable.

But now almost two years on, thanks to local builder Carl Palmer and a team of appointed specialists in fire restoration the family are back in their home in time for Christmas.

The family had been left devastated by a blaze which ripped through their home in Lymmhay Lane off Danebank Road during the

early hours of a Saturday morning. More than 30 firefighters were involved in tackling the blaze.

Pete Taylor who lives at the property in Lymm with his wife Kirsty and their three children said: "Following a lengthy tender process Urban were awarded the



Su's special day at the Castle




