Residents launch own Speed Watch campaign

RESIDENTS of Burford Lane, Lymm have embarked on their own speed watch campaign after becoming increasingly concerned over the the speed of cars travelling down their

Warrington Council refused to assess the speed limit down the lane citing a lack of resources, residents, supported by local Cllr. Kath Buckley decided to take action themselves and have formed an action group to petition the council to reduce the speed limit to 30mph.

Currently the limit stands at 40mph rising to 50mph near the end of Warrington Lane.

Local resident Sonia Tasker said:

Local resident Sonia lasker said:
"The speed limit is not only out
dated but is confusing to motorists
and many motorists flout the
already too-high speed limit.
"Walking down the lane,
especially with children, is
dangerous. In places, the pavement
is no more than a foot wide.

In addition, many residents, in particular the elderly, find it hard to pull out of their own drives."

Alongside a 150 signature petition, residents have been participating in a community speedwatch programme organized by PCSO Phil Redshaw.

Local residents have trained in using a speed gun and information on speeding traffic is passed on to Phil who sends out letters to anybody exceeding the

customers sustainably sourced fish, gluten free options and vegan options. Their shop is also plastic free and is a Chester Zoo Sustainable Palm Oil Champion.





Former Mayor visits Lymm Wellness and Mental Fitness Group

FORMER Mayor of Warrington, Geoff Settle gave a talk to the Lymm Wellness & Mental Fitness Group about his "experiences of living with bipolar."

Diagnosed back in 1997, after working on a high-pressure IT project, Geoff would arrive home and not say a word to the family. He used to train for running up to 80 miles a week - but he just stopped training.

changed His mood the project was delivered. "My depression lifted. I went from a low to a high mood. I was enthusiastic,

took risks.

"Fortunately, my wife arranged for me to meett a clinical psychologist. He confirmed a bipolar diagnosis, told me to take lithium and recommended a great read 'An Unquiet Mind' by Kay Redfield.

Back then there was no counselling in Warrington. His family and friends were key to his

wellness."

Geoff said to distract his thoughts when on sick leave, he spent time with his children had fun and took up watercolour painting, yoga and

In 2016 he helped set up the Warrington BipolarUK support group."The nearest BipolarUK group was then a round trip of 34

"Talking things through in a safe

environment really helps sufferers. Listening to their stories has taught me how easy a time I have had in

comparison."

When people arrive at their first bipolar group meeting, they expect tailor made solutions, but there are tailor made solutions, but there are no quick fixes, no wonder drugs "It is something that you will live with for the rest of your life. As a group we share our experiences and offer help, advice and support."

In 2017 Geoff finally received help for his bipolar when he was selected for a Lancaster University PhD study. He said "The study wanted to understand how bipolar people over the age of

sixty had survived. In return they taught recovery techniques such as Cognitive Behavioural Therapy Behavioural Activation meditation.

"With these tools and techniques your mental health toolbox bipolar can be a lot easier to live with but sufferers require professional help which is still hard to get." You can find out more about BipolarUK services, at www. bipolar.co.uk

As part of planning his estate Mr Smith wanted to ensure that his interest in the company passed in accordance with his wishes in the event of his death.

The company had been in the family for many years and Mr Smith wished to ensure that his children continued to benefit from the company after his death. It was Mr Smith's intention that any significant influence his children would have over the company should be held back until they were more mature had become more involved in the running of the business.

We discussed several options with Mr Smith who decided to include a gift of his shareholding into a discretionary trut

into a discretionary trust.

Effectively, on his death Mr Smith would gift his shares to the trust, for his appointed Trustees to run for the benefit of his children as the trust's beneficiaries, and appointed two of his fellow directors and minority shareholders in the company as the Trustees.

Mr Smith's children would not have any automatic right to benefit from the shares (whether as sale proceeds or dividend payments) dividend payments) nor to utilise any rights as a shareholder. as a shareholder. Instead, it would be at the discretion of the Trustees to make any payments out to the children from the trust fund.

The terms of the trust also granted Mr Smith's trustees the right to appoint all or part of the trust capital, in this case referring to the underlying shareholding, for the benefit of either or all of the children. This allows for the trustees to, at their ultimate discretion, grant some or all of the shares to the children as they

became more involved in the company.

Fears over "accident waiting to happen

expressed concern that a new,

expressed concern that a new, partially installed zebra crossing at Lymm is "an accident waiting to happen."

The crossing is being installed on the A56 Church Road by Warrington Borough Council, following a two-year battle to get it by Lymm Parish Council.

But although work started on it

But although work started on it some two weeks ago, involving the road being closed for two nights, it has still not been completed, with the flashing beacons still not

A number of residents have expressed concern that cars – and ice cream vans – parked at Lymm Dam – will block motorists' view of the pavement near the crossing and prevent them from seeing pedestrians about to step onto the

crossing.
One resident expressed "horror and deep concern" about the

crossing.

Philip Lovell said: "This is an

needs immediate action to avoid a serious incident with school children or people walking around

The crossing allows cars to park right up to the crossing therefore making it impossible for motorists to see if anyone is waiting to cross

until they are on top of the crossing.
"The crossing is at the bottom of a steep dip in the road where cars often drive fast.

Whoever designed this crossing needs to arrange for immediate alterations. The simplest way is to stop cars parking in the parking bays right up to the crossing." Cllr lan Marks – a member of

both the borough council and the parish council, said: "Lymm Parish Council has been trying to get this crossing for about two years and we believe the previous situation, with pedestrians crossing the road in an uncontrolled manner, was an accident waiting to happen.

"But I agree the present situation is not satisfactory and something needs to be done to get the work completed quickly and the flashing beacons installed. I have asked the borough council to get the work finished as soon as possible.'

A borough council spokesperson said: "Historically a substantial number of people used this specific location to cross unaided and very few would detour to a new crossing at an alternate location along the route. Therefore the existing uncontrolled crossing needed to be upgraded to the zebra crossing presently being installed. This crossing upgrade will increase the safety of pedestrians by warning approaching drivers in advance of the crossing - something that did not previously occur.

"Adjustments have been made to the pedestrian build out on the Dam side of the road to increase the visibility between pedestrians and approaching drivers passing by parked vehicles.

As with all pedestrian crossings introduced, many checks were undertaken including traffic speeds in both directions. This revealed that though there may be singular instances of speeding, the average speed was below national criteria used to assess the safe installation of zebra crossing provision.
