Steve Harper, Chair of the Lymm Dickensian Committee said: "Due to the ever-evolving situation with the Coronavirus and having taken on board the advice from the Government, Public Health England and the NHS we have been left with no other option but to cancel Lymm Dickensian 2020 to cancel Lymm Dickensian 2020.

"We appreciate the disappointment for all those who were expecting to take part in the parade and the thousands who tlock to the village for the day, and also to all the people and regarisations who have appointed." organisations who have supported us by booking stalls. However, we feel that it is the correct decision as we have to put the health and wellbeing of all who would have taken part as our priority in these

unprecedented times."
Secretary of the Dickensian
Committee Colin Oakley added:

"We have been reviewing the situation carefully in recent weeks hoping something might improve. However it is now abundantly clear that the current restrictions will be with us for the foreseeable future and the probability of large gatherings being acceptable in December is remote. We are bitterly disappointed after all the preparatory work that has been put in by the volunteers on the organising team.
"Our task now is to contact the

parade participants, stallholders and the various venues around the village to let them know of our

decision.

'Only a fraction of the single-use plastic we use is recycled, and an even smaller fraction of that is done in the UK - and we have all seen the images of our plastic rubbish being burnt at the roadside in places like Turkey."



DESPITE the ongoing problems caused by the COVID-19 pandemic members of Lymm Rotary Club are still hoping to bring some Christmas cheer to the village with their annual Santa float.

For over 50 years Lymm Rotary Club has been involved with organising the Christmas Float with Santa around Lymm and Thelwall. In recent years they have involved members from many of the good causes which operate in the area. This has worked very well and has meant that Rotary has been able to share any donations made with to share any donations made with these local good causes, thus in turn helping them in their works for the

coming year. Club spokesperson Colin Oakley said: "With the arrival of Covid-19 we now face new challenges, as does everyone else in the village. We are all aware that we have to social distance from people and this casts doubt on our ability to do a

"We are watching the news as the virus progresses but recently it has been seen to be getting worse. However, the members are still very keen to bring Christmas to the local people. If nothing else changes by December we are considering running the float around the routes that we normally visit, but with a minimum of support staff and we will not be knocking on any doors. "Unfortunately Santa will not be

able to talk to any of the youngsters as he will have to be distanced on the float itself, but will be able to be seen from people's front windows. All of this is subject to approval nearer the time from the local authorities and we will obviously have to take into account the prevailing rules and restrictions.

"We have been asked whether we could still raise money for the local good causes using electronic means and we are looking at options for doing this, however, the first rule has to be the safety of all involved.

"We will try our best to try to bring Christmas cheer to the area around Lymm. We will send out more information nearer the time to update people.

# Call for urgent action as third lorry involved in bridge incident



A CONCERNED Cllr. is calling for urgent action from highway chiefs following a third incident in recent weeks involving a lorry and a bridge at Lymm which has led to local traffic chaos.

local traffic chaos.

A lorry used for carrying a skip became stuck under an aqueduct bridge on Barsbank Lane, Lymm, recently, following on from two other recent incident involving HGVs getting stuck on humpback bridges in the village.

Local Cllr lan Marks said: "Coming on top of two recent groundings of vehicles on canal bridges, we now have a vehicle stuck underneath an aqueduct. This

stuck underneath an aqueduct. This caused chaos on Barsbank Lane and it is a common occurrence for vehicles being forced to turn round before they reach the aqueduct when they realise they cannot get through. Large vehicles should have proper Satnavs that stop them using roads where there are restrictions.

A standard TomTom or equivalent is no good. We need to look again the signage and make sure it is visible and clear. It would also help

# Lymm Rugby Club launch Centurions Crowdfunding Appeal

LYMM Rugby Club has launched a "Centurions Crowdfunding Appeal" with the aim of creating a Lymm RFC COVID-19 related Development Fund to ensure the club can survive the loss of income streams.

With the club facing a £100,000 shortfall due to the loss of income streams, including the popular Lymm panto this year, the club has applied for Sport England match-funding and is hopeful this will be supported, with an initial funding target of £10,000. If the club can raise the first £5,000 from over 100 donors,

they are optimistic Sport England will pledge to match their  $\mathfrak{L}10,000$ target with a further £10,000. In

addition, with the potential for the donations to be Gift Aided, this project could raise up to £22,500. Lymm RFC, therefore, needs to sign up a minimum of 100 donors to this scheme (members, family members, local businesses and non-

members) to demonstrate sufficient widespread support for the project and meeting one of the key tests to qualify for Sport England support – the 100 donors could include, for example, 4 members from one family each donating, say, £50

Lymm RFC is a registered charity
established in 1960 and is a true
community club. Having played
in the 5th tier of English rugby for
the past 10 seasons, puts the club
in the top 100 rugby union clubs
in the country. For many years, a
key strength of the club has been
their 350-400 strong Mini, Juniors
& Colts rugby section, which has their 330-400 strong Mini, juniors & Colts rugby section, which has been successful in providing the vast majority of their senior rugby players. In addition to rugby, they currently support squash, hockey and touch rugby, and, in the past, rugby league and netball. Plans to add touch to their specting stables. add tennis to their sporting stable are well advanced.

As a community club, the rugby club has always 'made ends meet' through regular fund-raising events and generating sponsorship, predominantly from local businesses. Key events are their annual Pantomime, which has now been running for over 30 years, members playing to an audience of 1,500 over 8 performances, and their Summer Marquee events, held in June. These two events generate a surplus of around £70,000 which is vital to balance the books. Covid-19 has reduced social

income significantly forcing the cancellation of the Summer Marquee events, as well as the Panto. In all, the club faces a £100,000 shortfall in income.
















### Ada Edwards
