Motorist who challenged fixed penalty notice fined £1,000

A motorist who ignored parking restrictions on a zebra crossing near Lymm Dam has been ordered to pay more than £1,000 in a fine and costs by Warrington Magistrates after contesting a fixed penalty notice.

penalty notice. The driver was issued a fixed penalty notice for unnecessary obstruction where the vehicle was parked on the zig-zags ast the crossing at Lymm Dam on Sunday 12th December last year. But the driver disputed the ticket and the case was heard at Warrington Magistrates on Monday 25th April.

A guilty verdict was found, resulting in a total fine and costs of £1,026.

Lymm Police are constantly warning motorists about parking on the zig-zags near the crossing at Lymm Dam.

Thousands flock to Lymm Duck Race



THOUSANDS of people flocked into Lymm village as the Lymm Duck Race returned after an absence of two years due to the pandemic.

Organised by Lymm Roundtable and supported by local businesses, the event is expected to raise over £10,000 for good causes, with a £5,000 donation already pledged to the humanitarian crisis in the Ukraine.

Members of the public also purchased hundreds of plastic ducks which were emptied in the lower dam in the middle of the village, with prizes for the first ones to cross the finish line.

Play your part as Lymm rises to the challenge!

THERE has been a fantastic response from the community to the launch of plans for a new centre for the performing arts in Lymm, with many groups who would use the centre getting behind the project.

Kieran Walshe, who chairs the Lymm Performing Arts Working Group, said: "We've had great support from groups and individuals from the outset and throughout our community consultation last year, but we were blown away by the response to the launch, on social media and in person.

media and in person." The plans envisage a new, purpose built facility on the Lymm High School site, to be used by all schools and the community. It will have a large, professionally equipped performance hall which can be used for big events such as

school productions, dance shows, concerts, Lymm Festival events, music gigs, and even touring companies and shows.

The school's recent production of the musical Grease (pictured) showcased the talent in the local community which will benefit from the project. The new centre will also have drama, dance and music also have arama, dance and music studios and practice rooms, media facilities, and a recording studio. It will be used by schools during the day and by the community in the evenings and at weekends. The Working Group is now

collaborating with Warrington Borough Council on bids for funding.

Kieran added: "This can't happen without a substantial capital investment from public funds, but we will also need to fundraise we will also need to fundraise from the community. We are starting discussions with a number of charitable funders, and we've already had one big donation from a local charity." The overall cost to build the performing arts centre will be around £3m, but fitting it out and providing equipment could add to that. LYMM PARISH COUNCIL NEWSLETTER

Lymm Parish Council is working hard with volunteers from the village to put on a full set of events and activities to celebrate Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Street parties, lanterns, craft activities, floral displays, decorations, church services, sing songs and the climax of lighting the Jubilee Beacon will all enable Lymm Residents to celebrate this unique event together. Lymm Radio will be providing full coverage.

A souvenir programme will be delivered to every home in the village.

Warrington's Local Plan has been submitted to the Government for its "Examination in public" which must be passed before the plan can be adopted. The plan has proved particularly controversial in South Warrington because of the amount of greenbelt that will be lost and the fear that it will allow unsustainable car-dependent estates of large homes, without delivering the affordable and sustainable homes that residents tell us they want.

Lymm Parish Council is a member of the South Warrington Parish Councils' planning group which will be funding a legal and a planning consultant to put the residents' view at the Examination.

The Council is looking for ways to expand and improve to work on maintaining the local environment. Our Environment Team has been much praised for the work they do and their "before and after" shots on Instagram.


The Parish Council will work with Warrington Borough Council to improve the coordination of adding and maintaining benches in our popular open spaces, as well as regularising the maintenance of memorial benches sponsored by members of the public.

We continue to receive a lot of complaints about speeding, parking and HGVs passing through the village. To have better grounds for negotiating with the Highways Department the Parish Council is funding ten monitoring cameras that count cars, pedestrians, cyclists and HGVs as well as providing an idea of the speeds at which these are passing through the village. The devices only count, they retain no data and do not identify vehicles or individuals. We are also waiting for news on our participation in an average speed monitoring pilot on the A56.

We hope everyone enjoys their Jubilee bank holidays.

As always, the Parish Council, is pleased to hear from the public, particularly from those who have ideas for improving life in Lymm.

"Superhero" twins raise £3k for research

IDENTICAL eleven-year-old twins Oscar and Sebastian Spink, who both suffer from a rare muscle-wasting condition, have raised over $\pounds 3,000$ for Muscular Dystrophy UK, after embarking on their biggest ever physical challengé.

The boys from Lymm were diagnosed with fascioscapulohumeral dystrophy (FSHD) in 2019 – a rare, progressive muscle-wasting condition that slowly destroys muscle, making any physical movement difficult, and there is currently no cure or treatment for the condition.

Now Oscar & Seb have completed their biggest physical challenge yet with a 2,000-step challenge at their Lymm home!

Mum Kery Spink said: "They are mad about Marvel and have been completing a massive task – to climb the equivalent of the Stark Tower from the Avengers films(we've given it a cheeky rename too) through April – that's 130 flights or 2000 steps! "Their muscles have got much

weaker in the past 12 months. They now have severe lordosis (curved spines) and shortening of their leg muscles, so climbing stairs is a real

effort for them. "They're fundraising for Muscular Dystrophy UK to help those with the condition and fund research into treatments for FSHD. There is currently no way to treat or stop the progression of this cruel condition, so we know they are going to get even weaker as time goes on, relying on their wheelchairs full time and needing full-time support.

"Every little bit of support helps MDUK reach those with muscle-wasting conditions and the search for

Last year the twins helped raise £13,000 from a whacky hair day at their local school, while the year before they raised over £4,500 by completing 26 laps of their garden. Lymm welcomes Ukrainian "guests" to village

THE first Ukrainian refugees have started to arrive in Lymm after villagers rallied to set up a support group, to help those fleeing their war-torn country following Russia's invasion.

While the war in Ukraine has shocked everyone, the response from Lymm has been to open up their doors to the refugees – more hospitably called 'Guests', and give refuge from the violence they have been experiencing in their country.

Dozens of people have registered for the 'Homes for Ukraine' scheme, offering everything from single rooms to whole houses. Lymm Local Lesley Loughridge

was one of the first to welcome her guests to the village. "I joined the Lymm Ukranian Group on Facebook and quickly matched with a young couple. We began chatting online, to learn of their situation. They were first bombed

on the 23rd February (they lived very near an air base), and didn't realise that within 6 hours their lives would change dramatically. They packed up what they could in the back of a mini and émbarked on a 6 week journey to Lymm, via Russia. We had an emotional meeting as they pulled up in their little Mini. They are totally adorable and we are now getting on with all the paperwork to get them ready to work, which they are very keen to

do quickly. It is so lovely to think you can do your little bit to help." Still waiting for their guests is Sheila and Eric Quirk. They signed up immediately for the homes scheme. Sheila said: "On April 2nd we offered to sponsor a family





of 5. Mum, Dad and 3 beautiful girls aged under 11. They live in Western Ukraine but close to the Western Okraine but close to the Belarus border., and they started the visa process immediately. So far, we have received 4 of the 5 visas after 4 weeks of waiting. Within days of submitting the visa, a council bouvie officer arranged a council housing officer arranged to visit our house to check that we had room for 2 adults and 3 children and another officer performed DBS checks as we were set to go - subject to finding some bunk beds and clearing out the wardrobes!"

Sheila has been working with lots of people in the village to plan to provide weekly meeting venues and social cafés for the guest families, so they can meet up during the day to a chat or to learn English. She added: "if you see posters in the village in Ukrainian or hear a foreign language emanating from the various meeting rooms in Lymm, stop by and say hello to our guests.

Working on the Village response team is Cllr Graham Gowland. Graham added "Lymm always steps up in a crisis, but seeing all the different people offering their the different people offering their homes, arranging support groups for both the hosts and guests and generally working together has been really inspiring. We've an amazing community and I know every Ukrainian will receive a warm welcome to the village." Q: My poodle always seems to have 'sleep' under his eyes. What is the best way to clean it?

A: Firstly I would advise having him checked out by a vet just to ensure that there isn't an underlying problem – especially if it is a new condition. You can clean the 'sleep' with an eye wipe, soft tissue or damp cotton pad but remember to use a separate one for each eye and use a fresh one each time.

Q: A female stray cat has 'adopted' us. We are happy to have her as a member of the family but we don't want her getting pregnant. Is a vet able to tell if she has been spayed?

A: Before you 'adopt' the cat make sure she doesn't belong to anyone else as she won't be the first cat to have two homes! Ask around the local area and take her to the local vet to see if she is microchipped. Vets can do blood tests to measure hormone levels which can indicate if she still has her ovaries, they could shave a patch of fur to check for a spay scar or perform minor surgery to check if a uterus is present.

Q: I noticed an advert for a vaccination that covers rabbits Myxomatosis and for Viral Haemorrhagic Disease. I have heard of Myxomatosis but not the other disease. What is it and how common is it?

A: VHD is a highly infectious and often fatal virus that first appeared in the UK in 1992. Because it transmitted by direct contact between rabbits or from surfaces contaminated by other rabbits



many owners of solitary rabbits did not want the vaccination. When your rabbit has its annual myxomatosis vaccination it will automatically be covered against VHD with this vaccine.

Q: My collie has started eating compost from the tubs in the garden. He is 16 years old and has never done this before. He is eating all his dog food every day so cannot be hungry. Can you offer any advise? any advice?

A: There are a number of reasons why he may be doing this. The first is that, like humans, as dogs get older they can undergo 'senile' changes which can result in odd behaviour. It could be due to a deficiency of a mineral substance in his diet but if you have not changed his diet recently this is unlikely. The third reason is a change in your dogs metabolism which means he cannot absorb the minerals he needs. It would be worth seeing a vet who can run tests and advice on the correct course of action.
