Editor's Comment

WHILE it was good to see local democracy in action during the recent protests against Warrington Borough Council's controversial low traffic schemes for Orford and Westy, one does have to question how effective local consultation has been on these projects.

As we reported on the schemes, the overriding message was that people didn't know about these proposals to change their local road networks.

Credit where credit is due to council leader Russ Bowden agreeing to receive a petition from Orford protesters outside the town hall, while a senior council officer accepted a similar petition from Westy residents outside another demonstration outside the Parr Hall at Full Council. Cllr. Bowden also went to the trouble of visiting a local business in Latchford impacted by the changes while also discussing and taking on board concerns.

While the decision has been taken to pause the Orford scheme, the controlling Labour group ignored pleas from opposition councillors and local residents at Westy to pause their scheme which will now come into force for a trial period.

The irony of the situation was that many, including myself, who had planned to attend at the Parr Hall, couldn't make it after becoming stuck in gridlock caused by a police incident on Kingsway Bridge which impacted on the local network. Traffic was literally bumper to bumper the entire length of Knutsford road, all the way back to Westy and the

Cantilever Bridge.

Despite all the measures being taken to resolve Warrington's traffic congestion, every time there is an incident on the motorway network Warrington is significantly impacted.

While I understand the need to make our residential roads safer and less polluted I fear these Low Traffic schemes will simply create more problems or push the problems elsewhere onto other roads.

Living in an age where people will still pay £100 to fill up their tanks while driving cars on a five-10 minute journey on the school run, no amount of highway schemes is going to detract from the problems. As human beings, we are often creatures of habit - and it is far too easy to jump into a car to make a short journey.

Until we can change peoples' habits we will not resolve the traffic

issues facing not just our town or country but most of the civilised world.

We certainly shouldn't just be spending money we have been given by the Government to try and resolve problems in a short time scale.

Hopefully, we can find a way forward but better consultation is clearly needed. Time and again I have told the powers that be that the ways of advertising public notices are outdated and not reaching people but again we are trapped in a system where old habits die hard.

Meanwhile, on a positive note, we are delighted to be supporting the TEDx event which was about to take place as we went to press, as our latest Legacy Project.

I have known TEDx organiser Kirsty James for the best part of a decade and have been impressed with her passion for the town and the local business community and I am certainly looking forward to TEDx becoming another positive event for Warrington.



Community centre opened in memory of Shannon Bradshaw facing closure due to funding crisis

IN the 20th anniversary year of the tragic death of Warrington youngster Shannon Bradshaw, a community centre opened in her memory 10 years ago could be forced to close due to a funding crisis.

Now founder Patti Bradshaw is appealing to the local business community to get behind the Shannon Bradshaw Community Centre at Penketh to help save it from closure, while also raising funds for the Shannon Bradshaw Trust, which helps raise funds to support families with poorly children.

To help support the local community, prices at the cafe are kept as low as possible, with a "belly-busting" full English breakfast costing just £6.50!

Patti is now appealing to the local community, in particular, local businesses to get behind the centre to help keep it open.

To help start the ball rolling, the Shannon Bradshaw Trust has become the latest beneficiary of a £500 **Warrington Worldwide** Legacy Project grant.

After experiencing firsthand the effects of having a child with a life-threatening condition and the trauma felt by the whole family, Patti and her husband Alan Bradshaw wanted to help other children and their families who sadly found themselves in similar situations.

Since 2002 the Shannon Bradshaw Trust has been raising

money through fundraising events that have helped many sick children and their families throughout the North West.

In February 2002 Shannon was diagnosed with a life-threatening condition Aplastic Anaemia. She

had just turned 7, before that she had been a happy, healthy little girl. After being told a bone marrow transplant was her only hope of a cure, but with no suitable donor on the register, her aunt Jackie organised Blood Donor clinics throughout the North West. This resulted in almost 7000 people registering with the Anthony

Nolan Trust, an organisation specialising in matching patients with suitable bone marrow donors. Unfortunately, by the time a perfect match was found Shannon was too ill to have the life-saving operation and sadly, on the 17 July 2002, just 5 short months after first diagnosis, she lost her brave battle.

Still plenty to be positive about despite challenging times

This year is proving to be a real challenge for both residents and local businesses as the cost of living crisis escalates, largely driven by the extreme energy price rises.

Although for some in the world these problems would be welcome if they were the worst they had to face, Warrington & Co witnesses this frequently, with key employers reporting fuel prices trebling and our infrastructure projects experiencing raw material increases every few days. Nationally, this has created the unwelcome combination of a stagnating economy and high inflation. It seems that we need to contract terms for things at the

moment so this becomes stagflation, which I can just about handle, but I refuse to use the term Jubiplats in relation to the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations, which I hope you all enjoyed.

Locally, however, Warrington is better shielded than many other locations, with a large logistics sector still benefitting from growing home deliveries and a nuclear cluster protected by 25 year government projects. The town centre was not

as badly affected by the pandemic and there are several exciting new arrivals at Time Square. Parlour are just about to commence fit-out of their new bar/restaurant, next to Costello's and Revolutions have confirmed that they will be coming to Time Square. We also hope to announce a further letting in the coming months. This interest in the Town Centre came back pretty quickly and has been constant, almost certainly helped by an award winning Market and comprehensive cultural programme, including the recent and always popular Neighbourhood Weekender.

In previous updates you've heard about our success in securing funding such as the Town Deal and the Zero Emission Bus Regional Areas (ZEBRA) and we continue to speak with Government about future spending. We have been allocated nearly £6.5m from the Shared Prosperity Fund and over £900,000 to improve adult literacy. Yes, it's around a third less than we received from the European Union, however there are fewer restrictions on how we can spend it. Warrington has a strong reputation with Government for public and private partnerships and we'll utilise this again to agree how



All set for 31st Disability Awareness Day

WARRINGTON Disability Partnership will host its 31st Disability Awareness Day on Sunday, July 17.

Since its humble beginnings three decades ago DAD, as it is affectionately known, has grown immensely and has taken place in 13 countries worldwide, the latest being Cameroon. DAD Warrington is recognised as the world's largest voluntary-led pan-disability event.

The historical Walton Hall and Gardens will once again, be the location for the event, which offers a tented village housing over 240 exhibitors promoting independent living, a "Can Do" Sports Zone with Scuba Diving in our onsite pool, Inclusive Cricket, Wheelchair American Football, Wheelchair Basketball, Total Tai Chi, Martial Arts, sports for blind and visually impaired people, Wheelchair, Physical Disability and Learning Disability Rugby League.

"The back-story to DAD is a great example of just how far a 'can do' attitude can take you," says Event Founder and Co-ordinator, Dave Thompson MBE DL. "What started out as a one-off, one-day event is now one of the highlights of the international disabled community's calendar – inspiring similar events as far afield as Cameroon, India, Uganda and Gibraltar!

"There is no greater satisfaction for me than seeing 'DAD's Army' of over 100 volunteers coming together to support people to enjoy and access our week-long programme of events – all of which are about celebrating diversity

and promoting independent living. A huge thank you to all of our sponsors – including principal sponsors Expanse Learning and United Utilities; there is something for everyone during 'DAD and DAD Week' and I urge people of all ages to take the opportunity to join us at Walton Hall Gardens".

DAD caters for families and people of all ages, with over 120 disability support charities, being pan-disability means there will be something for everyone, including mental health, sensory impairments as well as neurodiverse, physical and learning disabilities. Dozens of businesses will be promoting a wide range of mobility and independent products, wheelchair-accessible vehicles, car adaptations and Motability car dealerships, alongside statutory service providers, health, social care, education and employment.

The crowds in the Arts Marquee will be treated to acts including nationally acclaimed Ella Together Performance Group, plus Creating Adventures Beautiful Noise Choir, Carly Ryan, Dream Team Drama, BSL Signing Choir, Stars Drama, Signature Brass Band, and more. The Centre Arena entertainment included the Reach Sled Dogs, Birds of Prey, Physical Disability Rugby League and Martial Arts. A marquee will be dedicated to Silent Disco which offers visitors the opportunity to wear wireless

headphones (supplied) and select from three channels of music at the volume of their choice. Our Visual Arts Marquee offers painting, photography, poetry, and reading, including nationally acclaimed, Grandad Wheels storytelling.

One of the highlights of this year's show will be WDP's Disability Heritage Project which includes a display of vintage mobility equipment including a 1970's Invacar AC70, a 1917 three-wheeled invalid trike and a pre-WW1 wicker wheelchair.

DAD is free to enter and includes a free event programme. Check out the range of complementary

services: BSL interpreters, wheelchair and scooter loans, free park and ride and free buses from Warrington town centre.

The main day follows a week-long programme of events including Merseycare's Ignite Your Life, Mental Health and Well-being, Comedy and Curry Night in aid of the 2022 Physical Disability World Cup hosted by international star Adam Hills, Carers Well-being Day, and much more. Essay prize for philosophy student

A PRIESTLEY College student has won a Philosophy essay competition set by one of the UK's finest universities.

"I liked the challenge of answering the question and obviously there is an element of this being something I can put on my personal statement," said Cameron.


"It's an interesting question because we like to think that we all have free will, but there are things outside our control that mean this isn't the case."

Eventually they named 10 winners who each received a £25 voucher and invitation to a virtual workshop organised by the university's Department of Philosophy, involving academics and current students.

They said Cameron's essay was well written and followed a clear line of argumentation.

Inheritance Tax and Gifts!

It has been some time since we looked at Inheritance tax, which is payable on the value of a person's estate on their death.

It is payable at a rate of 40% on the excess of the estate above the current threshold of £325,000. For instance, if the estate is valued at £375,000 then you will pay 40% on the £50,000.

If you have a private residence and you leave that to your children or grandchildren then the £325,000 threshold can increase to £500,000.

Any assets owned by the taxpayer at the date of death are valued and included in the estate. In addition, if you have given any assets away in the previous seven years then these are also included in the estate, subject to taper relief for gifts made between three years and seven years before death.

Gifts made more than seven years before death are exempt from Inheritance Tax, unless they are **Gifts with Reservation**. These are gifts of an asset from which

you continue to receive a benefit.

An example would be gifting your house to someone but then continuing to live in it. Gifts with Reservation always remain wholly in your estate.

Some relief is available to spouses and civil partners. Firstly, transfers between spouses or civil partners are exempt from Inheritance Tax. Secondly, any unused allowances on the death of the first person can be utilized by the remaining partner on their death. For instance, if one partner passes £125,000 to third parties, with the balance going to the surviving partner then the balance of £200,000 can be added to that partner's tax free band.

Some gifts are exempt from Inheritance Tax and are not added to the estate even if made within the previous seven years.

Firstly, any gifts to **charities and political parties** are exempt from Inheritance Tax. There is no limit to the value of the gifts, so if you gift the whole surplus of your estate above the tax free

threshold to any charity or political party then you will not pay any Inheritance Tax.

Secondly, all **small gifts** of £250 or less to an individual are exempt. Only one gift each year can be made to the same person, and you must not have used any of the other gift exemptions listed below in that year to that person.

Thirdly, you can give away an **Annual Allowance** up to £3,000 in each tax year free of tax. This can be in one amount to one person, or made up of several gifts totalling £3,000.

Any unused allowance can be carried forward, but only for one year. Also, the allowance cannot be used to reduce the taxable value of a larger gift, so (subject only to any unused relief brought forward from the previous year) if you make a gift of (say) £4,000 then the £3,000 exemption cannot be used to reduce its value. It is all or nothing.

Fourthly, additional **Wedding Gifts** can be made to someone who is getting married as follows:

- £5,000 to a child

- £2,500 to a grandchild or great-grandchild
- £1,000 to anyone else.

Any unused Annual Allowance can be used if the gift exceeds the above.

Finally, **Normal Expenditure Out of Income** are exempt. To qualify, they must be regular payments made to the same person and are paid out of regular income having met all of your usual living costs.

Essentially, you can avoid surplus income from increasing your estate value but cannot decrease it by this means.

The above is a brief precis of a very complex area. Importantly, you will need to keep a record of gifts which show what you gave and to whom you gave it, when you gave it, and the value of the gift.

A total of 11 players, including skipper Mark Roberts and strikers Josh Amis and Jordan Buckley, have agreed terms for next season.

Long-serving Bohan Dixon and Mitch Duggan, midfielders Jay Harris and Sean Williams, and defender Evan Gumbs will also remain in Yellow.

Matthew McDonald, who played just once in an injury-hit campaign, remains along with Luke Duffy and recent signing Michael Howard.

Injured trio Jack Mackreth, Dom Reid and Mo Ali, who suffered a season-ending injury back in September, are all continuing their injury rehab with the club.

Defender Matt Regan and midfielder Ben Hough have left to join Ashton United, despite being offered new deals by the Yellows, and they have been joined by James Baillie, who was released.

Left-back Lewis Coulton has returned to Preston following his loan spell, and reserve goalkeeper Josh Ollerenshaw has also

departed.

Meanwhile, the Yellows were shortlisted for the Northern Premier League Club of the Year award.

They finished runners-up to eventual winners Stamford at the NPL's end of season presentation awards in Birmingham recently.
