The gift of running

LYMM Runners – widely acknowledged as one of the friendliest running clubs in the North West – have come up with a novel seasonal gift idea.

Instead of socks, woolly jumpers noted of socks, woolly jumpers or candles for that special person, how about the Gift of Running – a place on their 2023 Beginners Course?

Registration is now open for this very popular course which starts on Tuesday, January 10.

It lasts nine weeks, is open to runners and would-be runners of all abilities and consists of two onehour sessions a week.

On Tuesdays there is a structured coaching session at Victoria Park running track, Latchford and on Thursday evenings there are confidence-building group run/ walks, starting from Lymm High School.

There is plenty of encouragement well as structured coaching by qualified leaders in separate

training groups – so no one gets left behind. The course is free but participants are asked to join Lymm Runners for the start of the course.

Membership costs from just £20 a year but the club recommends joining England Athletics as well,

This gives some great benefits including reduced race cost entry and discounts on various products. Another optional extra is entry to the High Legh 10K on March 12 which many beginners on the

course work towards. Alison Felstead, beginners lead and run co-ordinator, said:"I've been one of the leads for this course for the past four years and have loved seeing the runners progress and gain in confidence.

Many join with very little previous running experience and amaze themselves by what they achieve in such a short space of time.

One of last year's graduates said: "I apprehensively joined the Lymm, Runners beginners' class I hadn't properly exercised since before lockdown and had done little running. The aim was to have fun, get fit, with a view to being able to complete the High Leigh 10k run in March.

'We were promised on day one we were going to love running, and I can honestly say, I had a smile on my face every time we went out. I got fitter quite quickly - the Tuesday sessions were informative and fun and the Thursday night running sessions in and around Lymm were tantastic

"I did the 10k run, thoroughly enjoyed it and have done two more since!'

Poppy Appeal team raised £21,429

A TEAM of more than 50 volunteers stepped up to help the Poppy Appeal in and around Lymm to raise a wonderful £21,429.62 in November.

The money goes to help ex-service personnel and their familieis who are in need - and In 2021 alone, 37,341 requests for help and support were received by the Royal British Legion.

In a statement thanking the people of Lymm for their generosity, the Lymm Poppy Appeal fundraising team, said: "Service men and women make a choice to put Servie above Self, but for some, the consequences can take a severe toll on their physical, mental, and emotional well-being. For those who are struggling to ror mose who are struggling to manage or to cope in their lives, the Royal British Legion, via the funds raised during the Poppy Appeal, are there to pick up the pieces "The money raised enabled the Legion to support 3,800 people through the Branch Community support service It enabled the Battle

support service. It enabled the Battle Back Centre, which specialises in short term courses involving adaptive sports and adventure opportunities,



to get hundreds of ex- service personnel back into civilian life.

"It helped to support Recovery Centres across the country in their work helping wounded, injured and sick personnel. It also helped in the funding of the Complex Trauma Gym at Stansfield Hall near Loughborough. The Admiral Nurses were able to continue their invaluable support as were the specialist RBL Care Homes

across the country. "Your support also helped the RBL to provide financial support for the participants in the Invictus Games.

Through the money raised during the Poppy Appeal they were also able to fund BRAVO 22 to aid recovery through art and drama.

Significant funding helped the 1,780 beneficiaries who sought specialist debt and money advice and millions were spent on research into the nature of injuries and medical treatment.

The fundraising team also thanked the shops, businesses, pubs, restaurants, schools, churches, garden centres, nurseries and other organisations who had collecting tins and Poppy boxes, as well as Lymm Air Training Corps for putting up lamp post poppies.

Road closures planned at Lymm for new traffic calming features

A number of phased road closures are being planned at Lymm in January for new traffic calming features.

Warrington Borough Council

Warrington Borough Council has given notice it intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of driving and footway closure as follows: (1) Eagle Brow from its junction with the A56 Church Road/Booths Hill Road to its junction with Brookfield Road; (2) Brookfield Road from its junction with Eagle Brow to a point junction with Eagle Brow to a point

approximately 55 metres south (at the access to Lymm Tennis Club); (3) Eagle Brow from its junction with Brookfield Road to a point approximately 70 metres east, approximately outside No. 38.

The Order will be effective from 16th January 2023 for 6 weeks, as and when signed on site.

The works will be implemented in phases as follows: Phase 1 (Item 1) – Starting 16/01/23 for 3 weeks,



THE winners of Lymm Parish Council's Lymm Village Future Vision Exhibition have been announced.

Winner was Sebestian Cowley, a student at Lymm High School, with his imaginative Sunken Water Garden, while pupils from Cherry Tree Primary School came runners-up with their fantastic model. Third was Lymm High student Danny Cornwall with his 3-D CAD design of the Sunken Garden Rejuvenation.

This summer, Lymm Parish Council invited young people across the village schools to submit entries to Lymm Village Future Vision Exhibition.

Lymm Village Future Vision Exhibition. The concept was to generate fresh ideas for how Lymm's young people imagine a village of the future. The exhibition was hosted at Lymm Heritage Centre during November. More than 20 entries were submitted and the quality of the work was exemplary. The ideas ranged from transforming the sunken garden into a play area, a community garden complete with water features and lighting driven by the Lower garden complete with water teatures and lighting driven by the Lower Dam, amphitheatre with performing arts platform and sculpture, sails overhead for shelter, to better village signage, electric charge points, cycle lock-ups, wider pavements for safer pedestrian access whilst facilitating an outdoor cafe society lifestyle. Entries were submitted in a wide range of art mediums range of art mediums.


Third: Danny Cornwall, Lymm High for his 3-D CAD drawing entitled Sunken Garden Rejuvenation.

Keven commented "It was great to be involved in this event. The number and variety of submissions was really impressive and the students all produced interesting and thought-provoking designs. It was obvious that a lot of effort went into producing the work and it is very encouraging that so many wanted to be involved in the future of the village. The approaches varied from highly analytical studies to free-form creative/emotive responses and there was plenty to discuss which made it very difficult to judge."

The public was also welcomed to make comments in the Bright Ideas Book. Lymm Parish Council will now start the process of cataloguing the work and will consider how these ideas might be capitalized as ideas might be capitalised on.

Cllr Steve Towndrow, who helped organise the event, thanked the schools, pupils, judges and Lymm Heritage Centre for contributing to an outstanding event that will help shape the future of Lymm as we move forward into the 21st century.

Q: My dog had developed a number of warts along her back. She is 9 years old. What should I treat them with?

A: You need to check with your vet that they are just warts. There is no treatment to stop them growing. If they are just warts or cysts, they are fine just as long as they are not irritating your dog. If they become too large or start to irritate her, they can be surgically removed.

Q: I have a 3-year-old, neutered, male cat, who sprays inside the house, I thought neutering may have stopped this.

A: Spraying is a normal behaviour in cats, and neutering doesn't always stop this behaviour – in both male and female cats. Spraying (after neutering) is often the result of carting strays is other start of certain stresses i.e. other cats, changes in environment etc. but could also be medically related. Your vet will be able to rule out any medical problems and provide you with advice to stop this anxious behaviour

Q: I have a 7-year-old Netherland Dwarf Rabbit who has started to look thin although he seems to be eating well. What could be causing this?

A: It is difficult to diagnose this without examining your rabbit so I would suggest that you take him to see a vet. It could be that think because of teeth or digestive troubles, or he could have an underlying illness.



Q: My dog suffers from arthritis. Can I give him 'human' pain killers? A: No. Many painkillers that are formulated for humans are extremely toxic to dogs. For instance, Ibuprofen can be fatal for a dog. There are licenced veterinary painkillers that have been extensively trialled on dogs and are proven to be safe to use.

Q: What is the rabbit disease VHD? A: VHD is a highly infectious and often fatal virus that first appeared in the UK in 1992. Because it is transmitted by direct contact between rabbits or from surfaces contaminated by other rabbits, many owners of solitary rabbits did not want the vaccination. There is a vaccine to cover against VHD and myxomatosis, another disease that can prove fatal to rabbits.





Speedway legend Peter Collins releases his long-awaited autobiography

LOCAL speedway legend Peter Collins has just released his long-awaited autobiography.

known as 'PC' is also England's most capped international with 154 appearances for his country.

After a debut season in grasstrack, Collins – the eldest of five racing brothers, speedway's greatest dynasty – rode for Belle Vue from 1971 until the end of 1986. In the winter of 1987-88, he became a copromoter of the famous Manchester club, leading the rescue mission that saved them from near extinction.

"I've waited a long while to tell my story and, as none of us is getting any younger, now is the right time," says Collins, now retired and living with his wife Angela at High Legh. Father of two Collins became

a speedway superstar during the sport's last golden era of the 1970s, when it regularly attracted five-figure crowds and he earned more per week than the top footballers at Mancherter United and Man City Manchester United and Man City. When Collins won his individual world crown in Poland in 1976, he was cheered to victory by a capacity 120,000 crowd.

"I was very lucky to reach my peak during a very special time for speedway, when all the big meetings were shown by ITV, the national daily papers gave it massive coverage, and we had international sponsors.

"I was born and bred in Partington and the farm where my brothers and I grew up set us on the path to speedway fame. My dad made my first bike – a 98cc James – when I was eight-years-old, and that's when began learning to slide round

"We built our own racetrack at Homestead Farm and on adjacent marshland. Most of the other local kids who had bikes and came to race with us also ended up having good careers in speedway or grasstrack racing. The Lymm area has a proud history of producing successful sporting motorcyclists."
